WSPS has nominated Nicholas Ladell, DPH-3, for the good government award for his work as the coordinator for the WSPS Student Political Action Network (SPAN). The Student Good Government Affairs Award is presented to a member of the Pharmacy Society of Wisconsin who has demonstrated a strong commitment to the advancement of the practice of pharmacy in the legislative arena.
