## Voting Record

### Purpose of this Guide

PSW does not endorse candidates for office; however, we know that many of our members consider how legislators voted on issues related to pharmacy in their voting decisions. This guide is designed to succinctly show how members of the Wisconsin State Assembly and Wisconsin State Senate voted on bills that PSW actively supported or opposed during the 2023-2024 legislative session. **This guide should not be seen as an endorsement of any candidate.**

### A Note Regarding Redistricting

Due to significant changes to the district maps of both the State Senate and State Assembly, the districts in which several legislators reside have changed; therefore, the district they are running to represent has changed. The district in which you live may also have changed. In many cases, your 2023-2024 representative may be running for reelection but will not be representing your address, and a different incumbent (or no incumbents) will be running for your representation.

Following the instructions below, “How to Read the Voting Records,” will help you determine your district for the 2025-2026 legislative session (the session that will be represented by the winners of the Fall 2024 election).

This guide sorts all legislators by the district they are running to represent in the 2024 fall election, not their current district. Legislators not on the ballot for this year’s Wisconsin State Legislature elections are included at the bottom for reference.

Please note that in one situation, Assembly District 24, two incumbents (one Democrat and one Republican) are running against one another.

## How to Read the Voting Records

1. [Click here](#) and enter your address to see your district number and the names of candidates running for State Assembly and State Senate on your ballot.

*Please note that not all State Senate districts will have elections in 2024, so you may not see a ballot option for the State Senate. All State Assembly districts are up for election in 2024.*

2. Find the district number of the incumbent candidate on the Voting Record under the column "District (2024 Election)."

*Please note that several districts do not have any incumbent legislators running for reelection.*

3. For each piece of legislation, we have provided information regarding whether the legislator cosponsored/authored it, their committee vote (if applicable; not all legislators serve on all committees), and their final floor vote on the legislation.

**Green** = vote / co-sponsorship aligned with PSW position

**Red** = vote / co-sponsorship did not align with PSW position

DNV = did not vote

4. Total percent alignment with PSW positions can be found in the last six columns of the spreadsheet.

# INFORMATION ABOUT EACH BILL

## **PBM Reform**

**PSW Position:** Support

This bill includes several payment-related reforms, including 340b non-discrimination, prohibitions on PBMs reimbursing affiliated pharmacies a higher rate than non-affiliated, mandatory mail-order, increased cost sharing for mail order, and adjudication fees, any willing provider provisions, and minimum dispensing fees.

***Note:** this bill did not pass either house of the legislature*

## **Contraceptive Prescribing**

**PSW Position:** Support

This bill would allow pharmacists to independently prescribe patch and pill contraceptive products for patients aged 18 and older.

***Note:** this bill passed the Assembly but not the Senate, so it was not eligible to be signed into law*

## **Rural Pharmacy Practice Grants**

**PSW Position:** Support

This bill provides up to \$90,000 of financial assistance to recent pharmacy school graduates who practice in a medically underserved area for at least three years after graduation.

***Note:** this bill did not pass either house of the legislature*

## **Elimination of the MPJE Examination**

**PSW Position:** Support

This bill would eliminate the requirement to pass the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination (MPJE) to be eligible for pharmacist licensure in Wisconsin.

***Note:** this bill passed the Assembly but not the Senate, so it was not eligible to be signed into law*

## **100-Day Prescription Coverage for SeniorCare**

**PSW Position:** Support

This bill allows SeniorCare patients to receive up to a 100-day supply of certain prescription drugs if authorized by their prescriber.

## **Requirement to Dispense All Prescription Orders**

**PSW Position:** Opposed

This bill requires pharmacists to dispense any prescription order received unless it is fraudulent or there is an absolute contraindication for the patient.

**Note:** *this bill did not pass either house of the legislature*

## **Repeal of the Unfair Sales Act**

**PSW Position:** Opposed

This bill removes the prohibition against selling vaccines, prescription drugs, and other qualified medical expenses for less than the cost of the merchandise to the seller.

**Note:** *this bill did not pass either house of the legislature*
