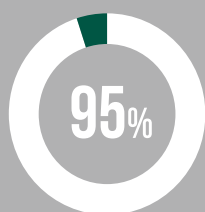
1 Design a sustainable medication adherence training program with all 3 schools of pharmacy in Wisconsin

2 Develop a medication adherence credentialing program

3 Disseminate medication adherence information to healthcare professionals and the public



In **2018** PACC conducted a medication adherence perceptions survey of pharmacy leaders throughout Wisconsin



More than **95%** of respondents believe medication adherence is a **priority** within their organization and important to population health

70% of pharmacists believe their patients are **50-80% NON-ADHERENT** to treatment regimens which is consistent with published literature

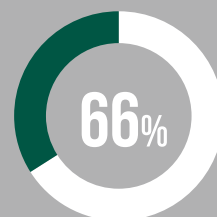


Survey results:
87 responses which included community and hospital pharmacy as well as home infusion, long-term care, specialty and compounding

More than 50% agreed that pharmacists in direct patient care roles would **benefit from additional training** in medication adherence assessment and interventions



66% agreed that pharmacists are the most appropriate healthcare professional to address adherence
