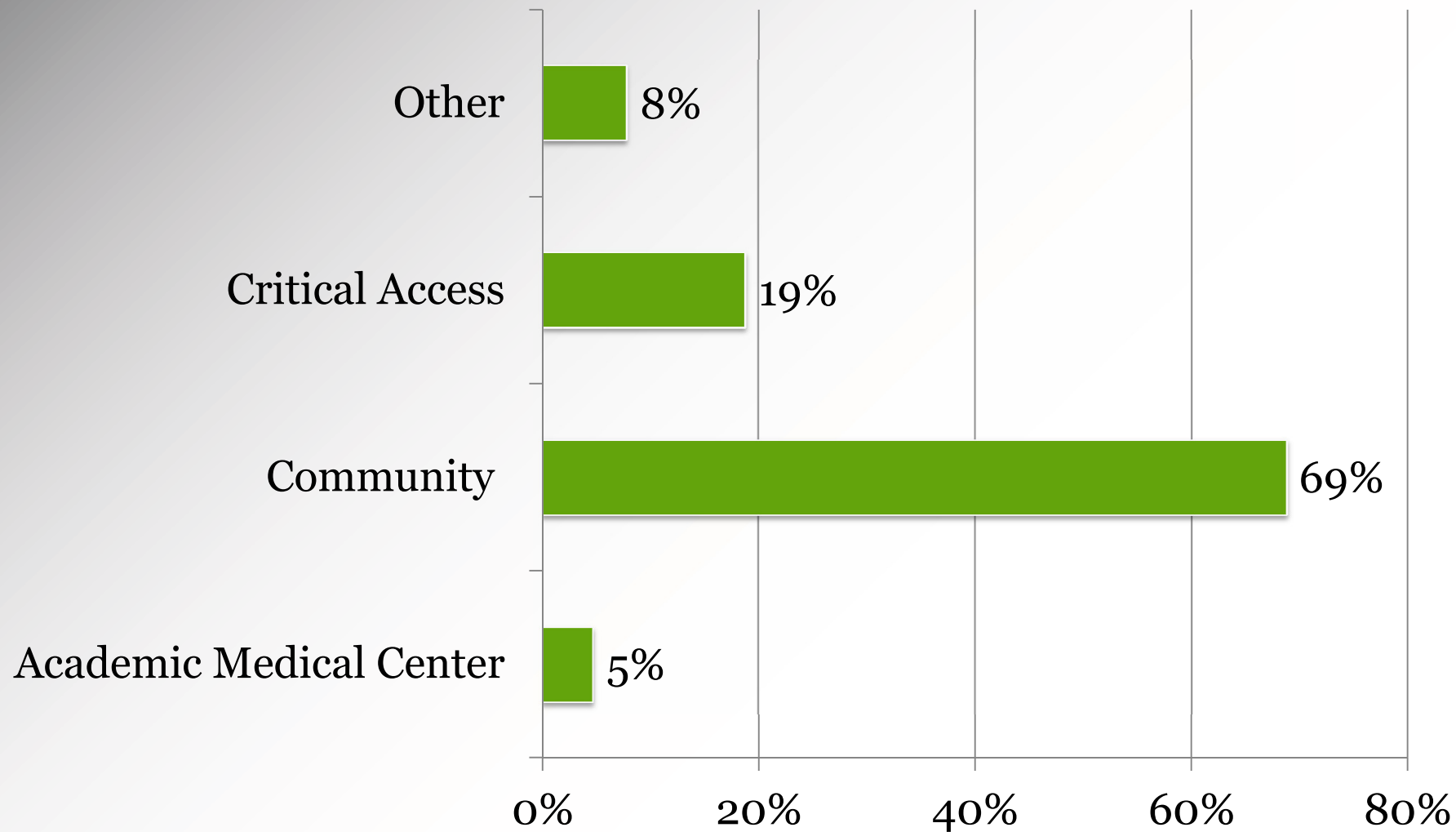

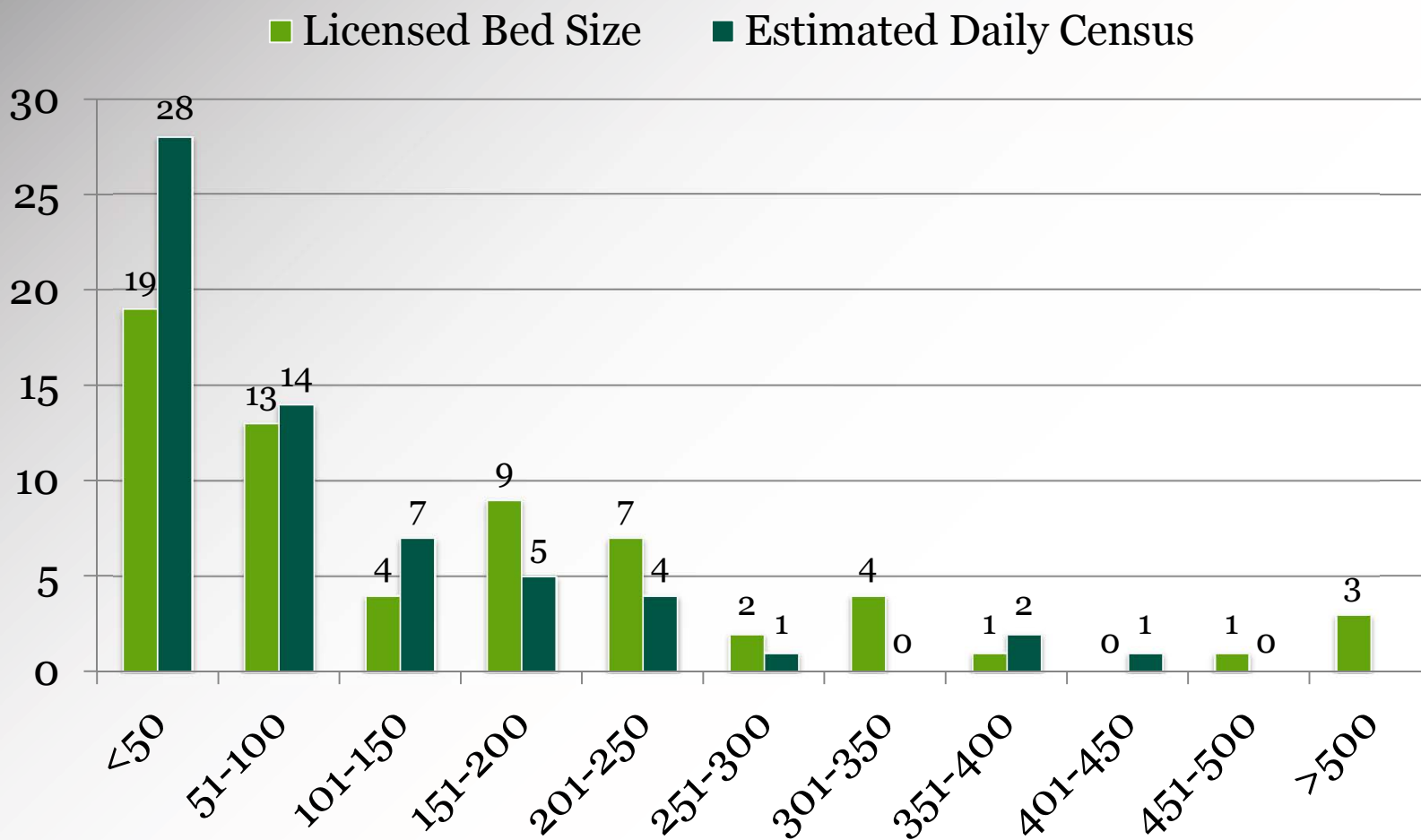

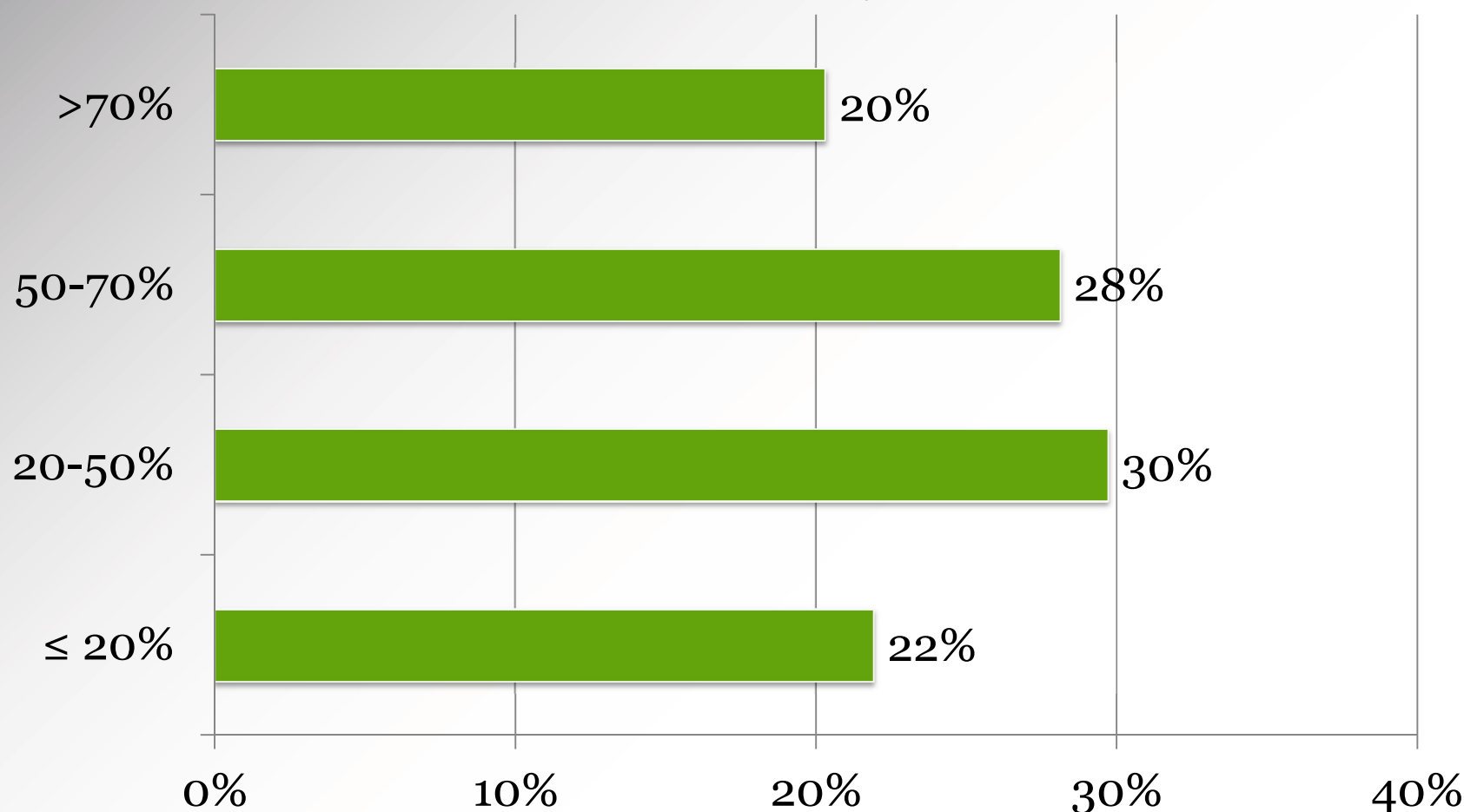
Licensed Bed Size and Estimated Daily Census

What Percentage of Pharmacist Hours are Available for Direct Patient Care Outside the Pharmacy?

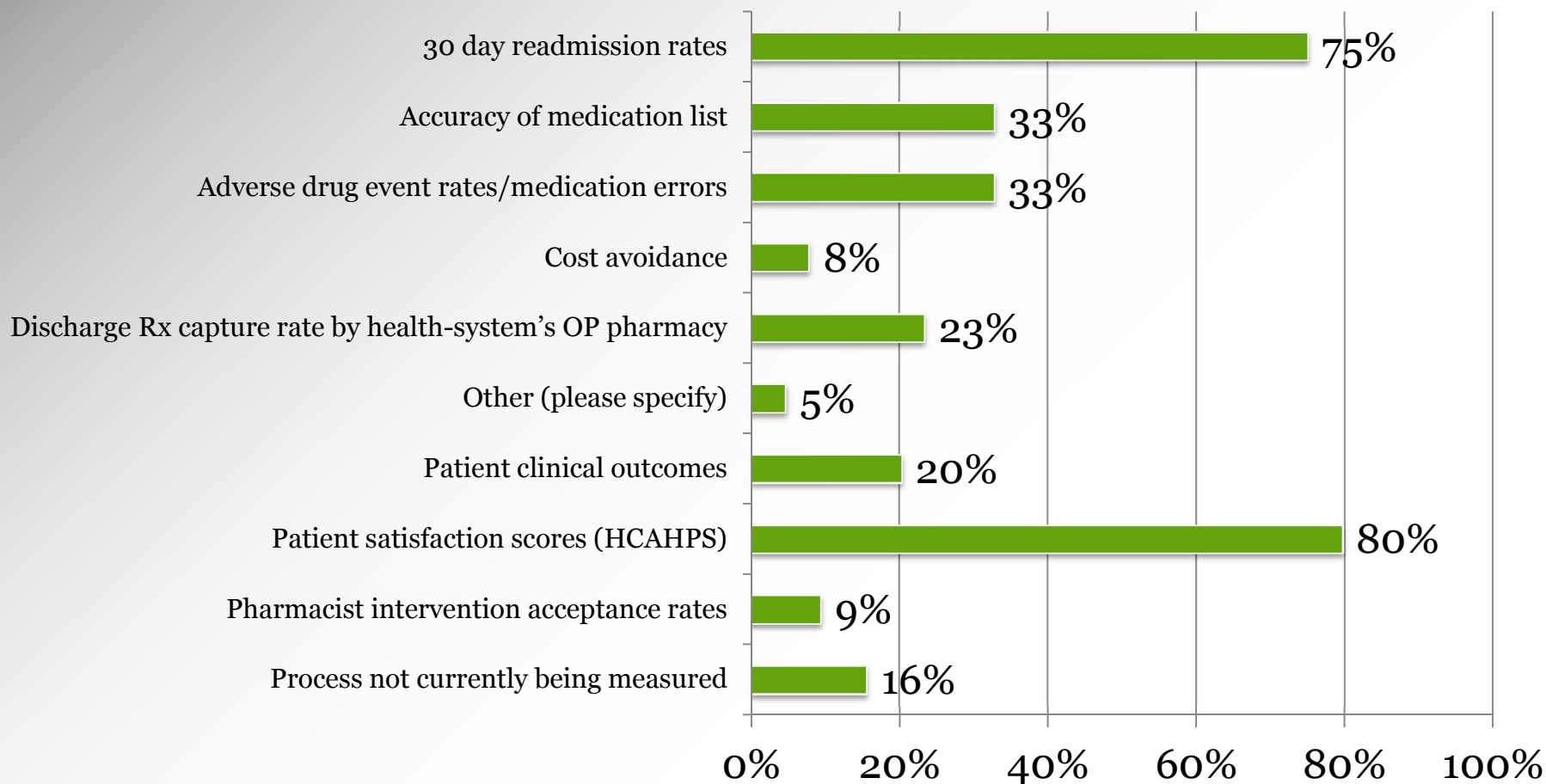

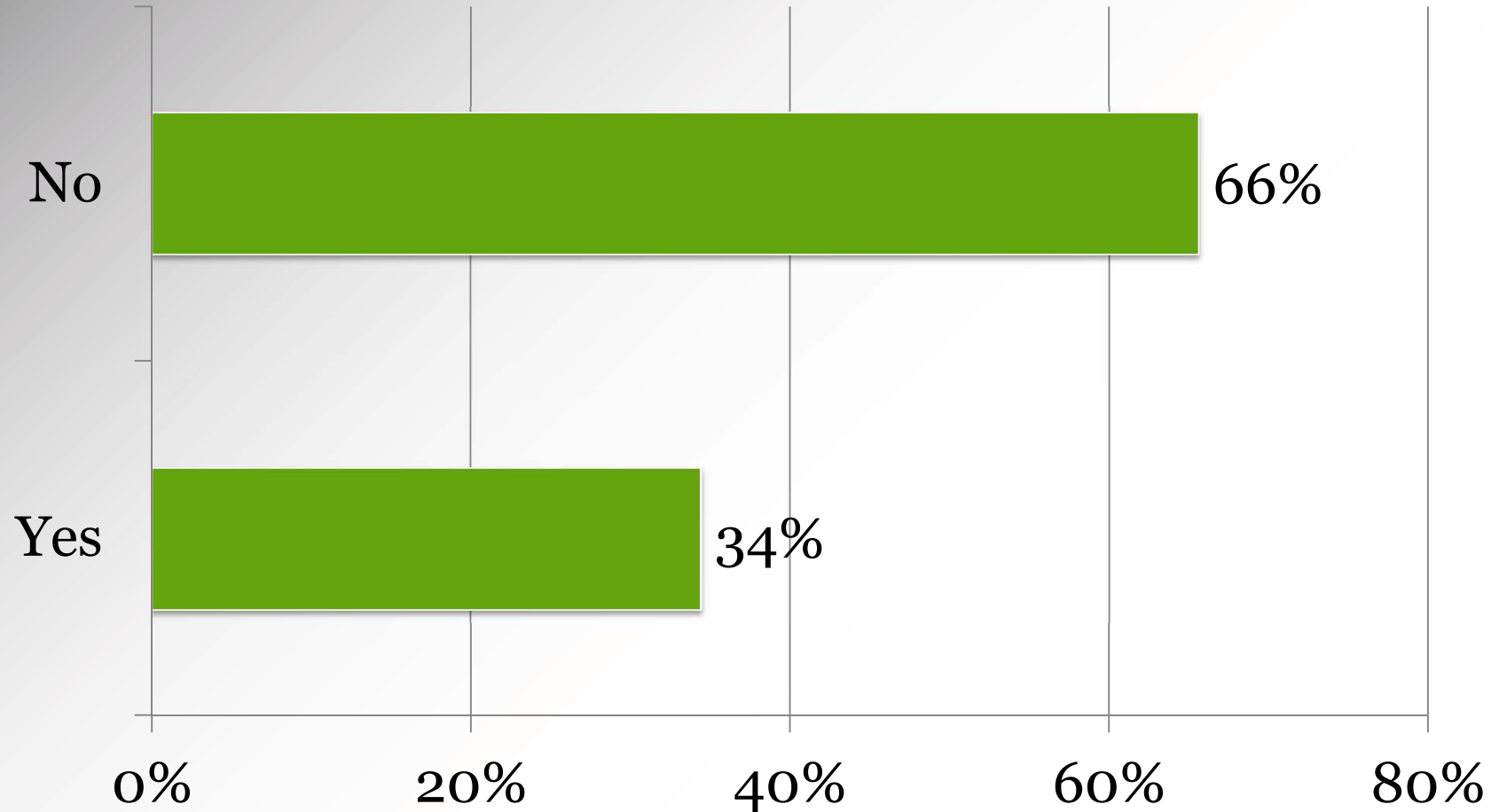
What Metrics are Used by Hospital Administration to Evaluate Discharge Medication Process?

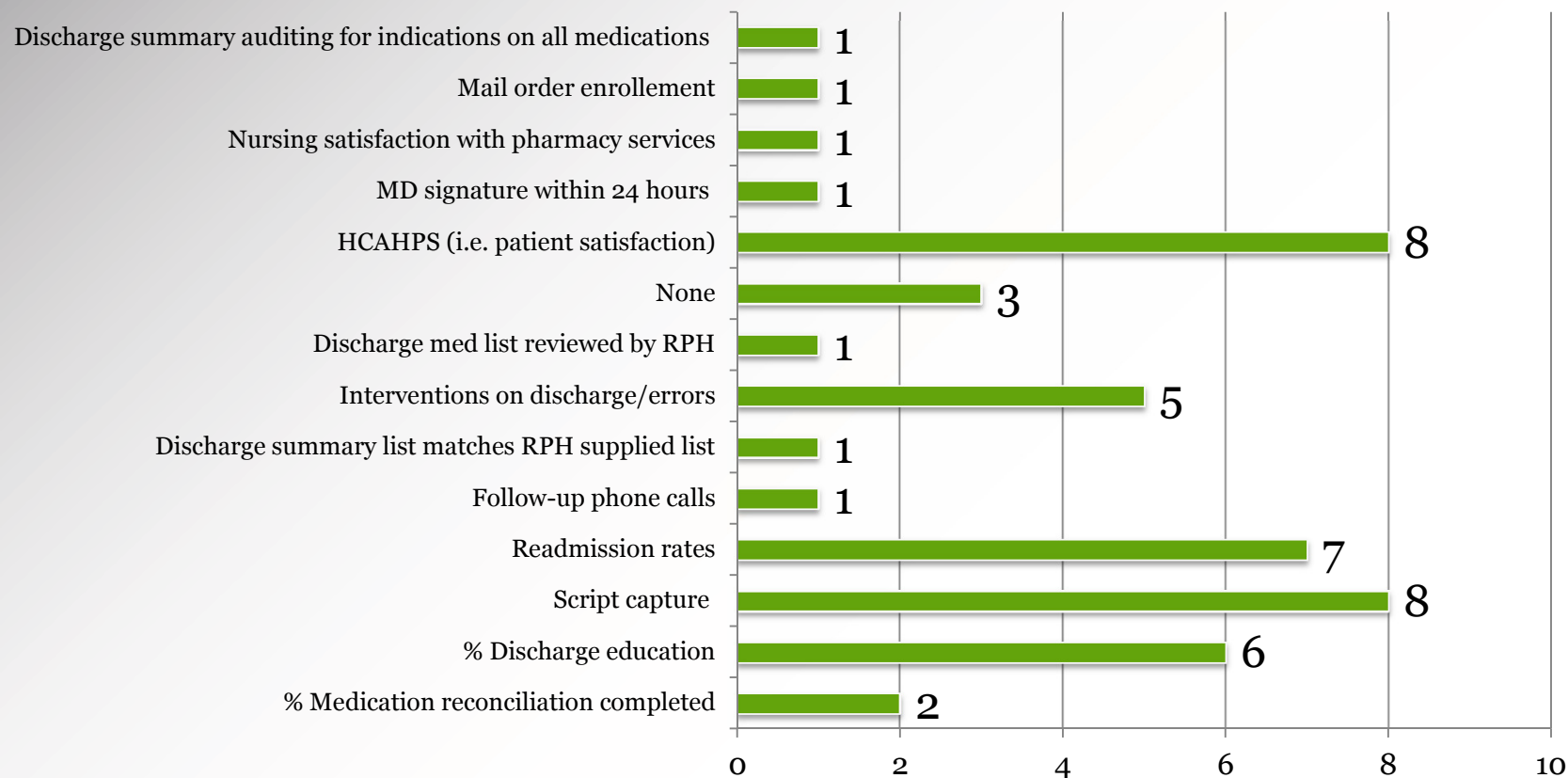

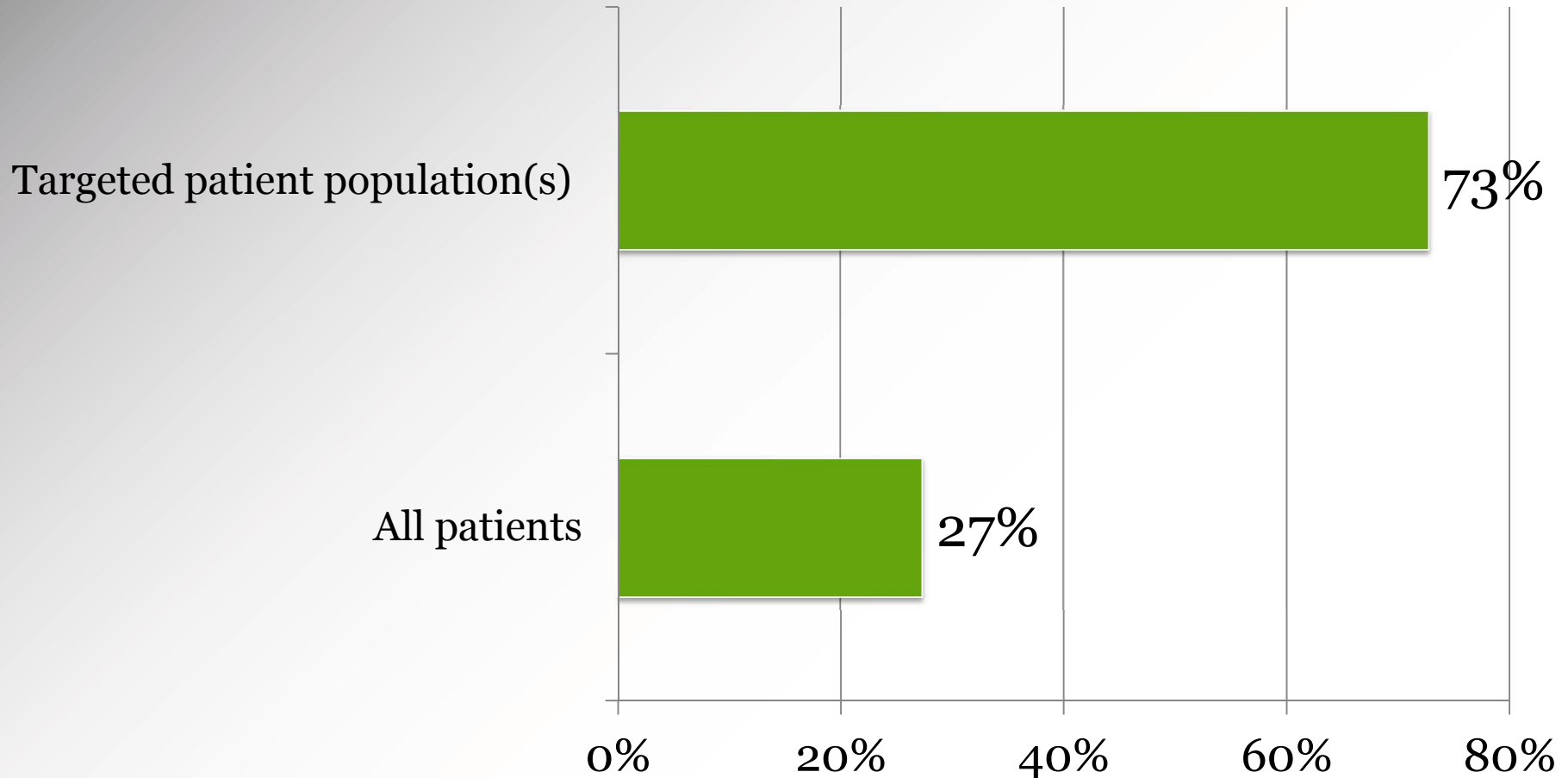
If your health-system provides pharmacy led transitional care discharge medication services, what metrics are used to objectively measure program success?

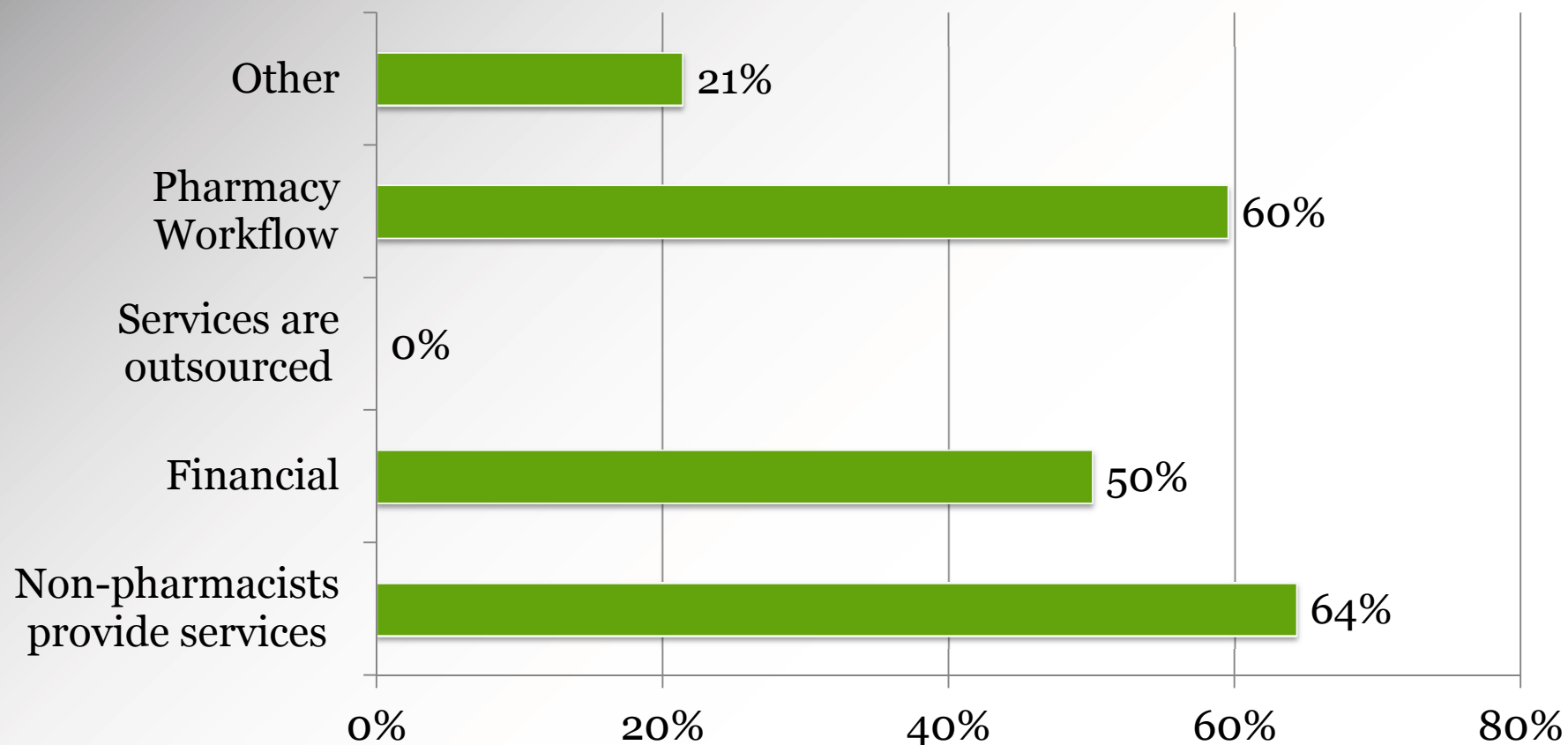

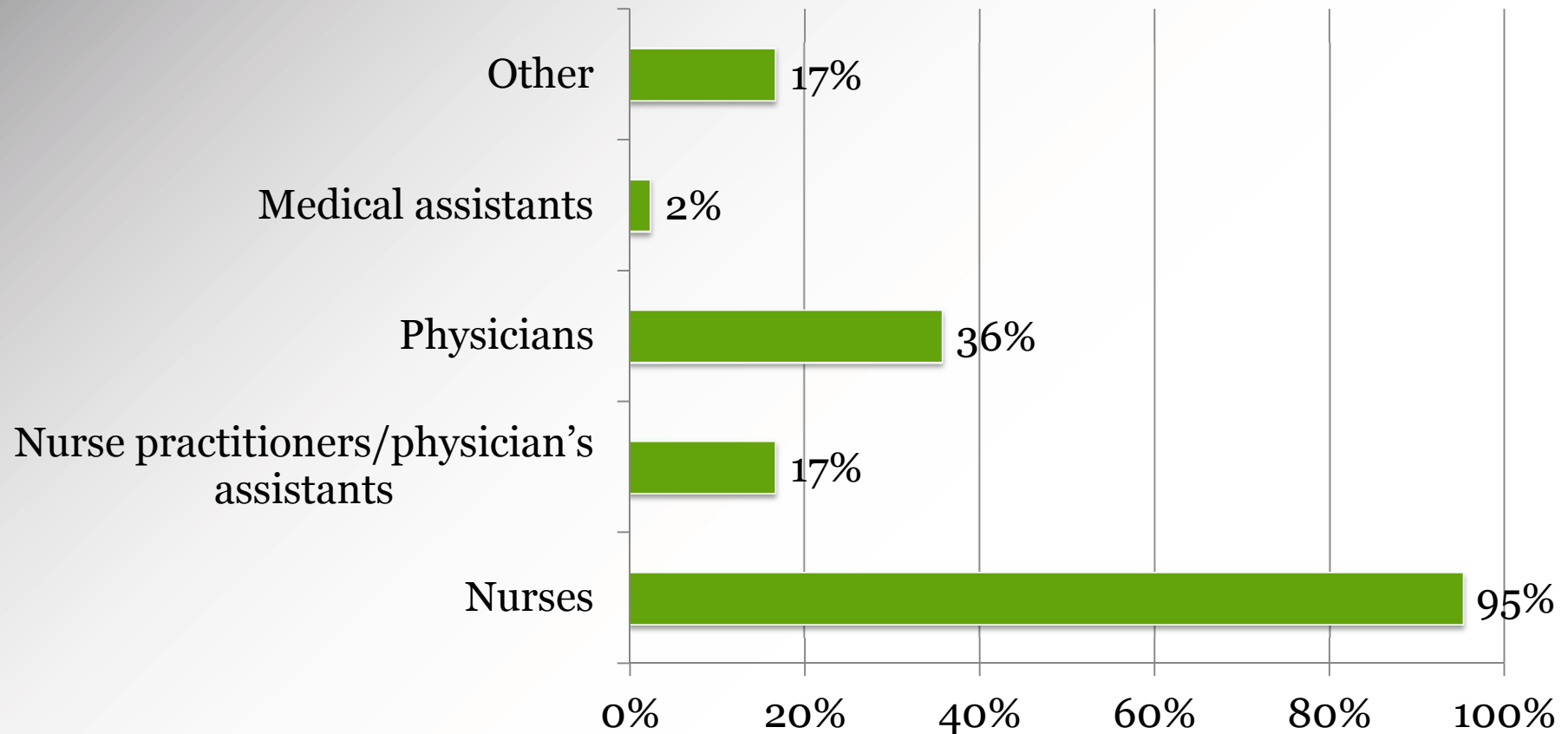

If the Pharmacist is Not Involved in Discharge Medication Reconciliation, Who Facilitates These Services?

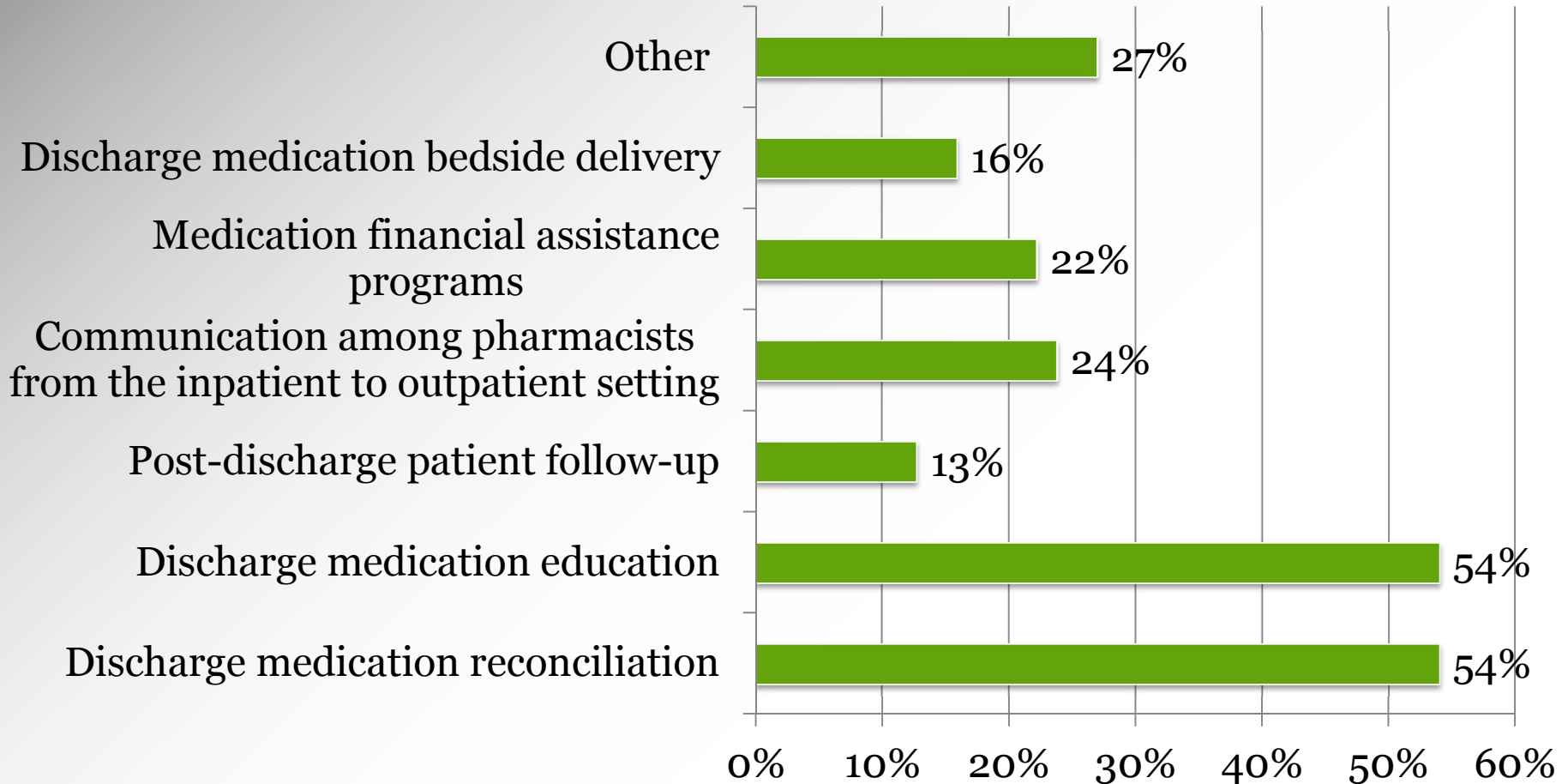

In Which Transitional Care Discharge Medication Activities Does Pharmacy Participate?

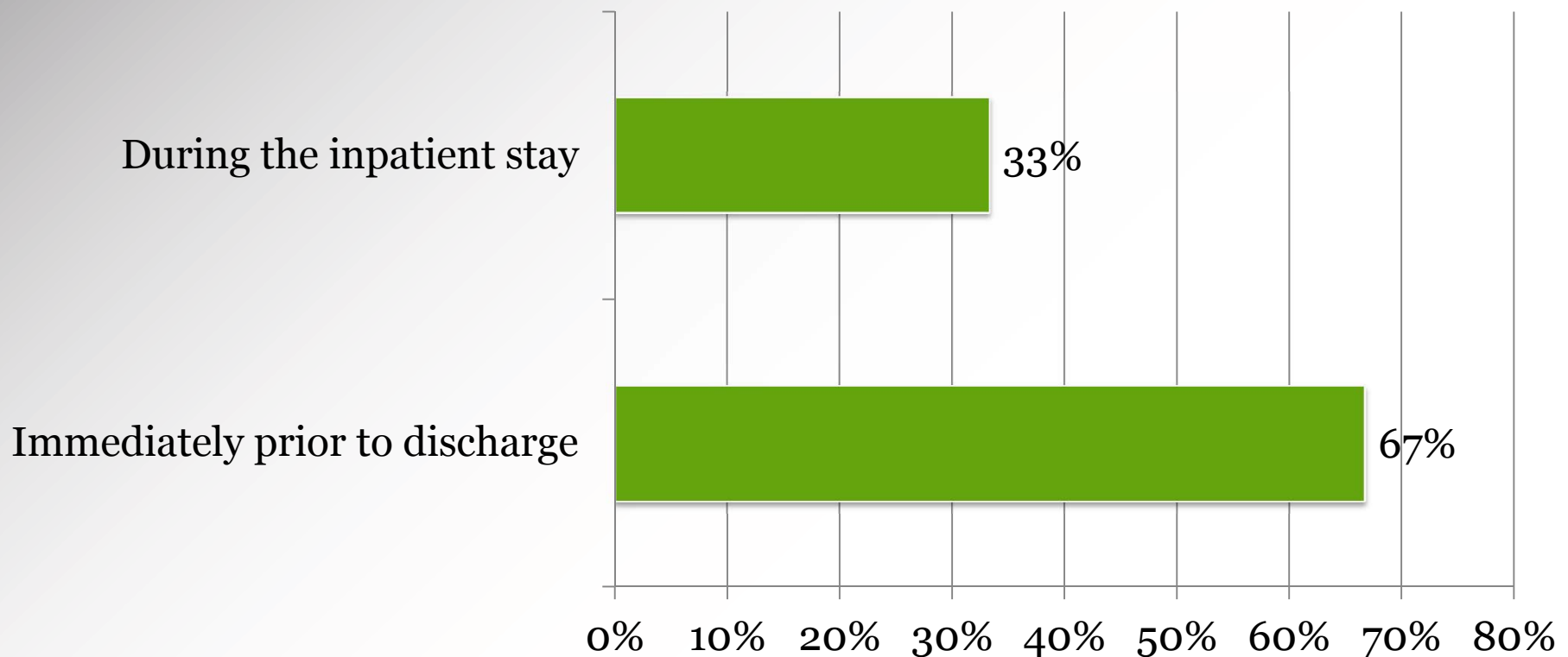

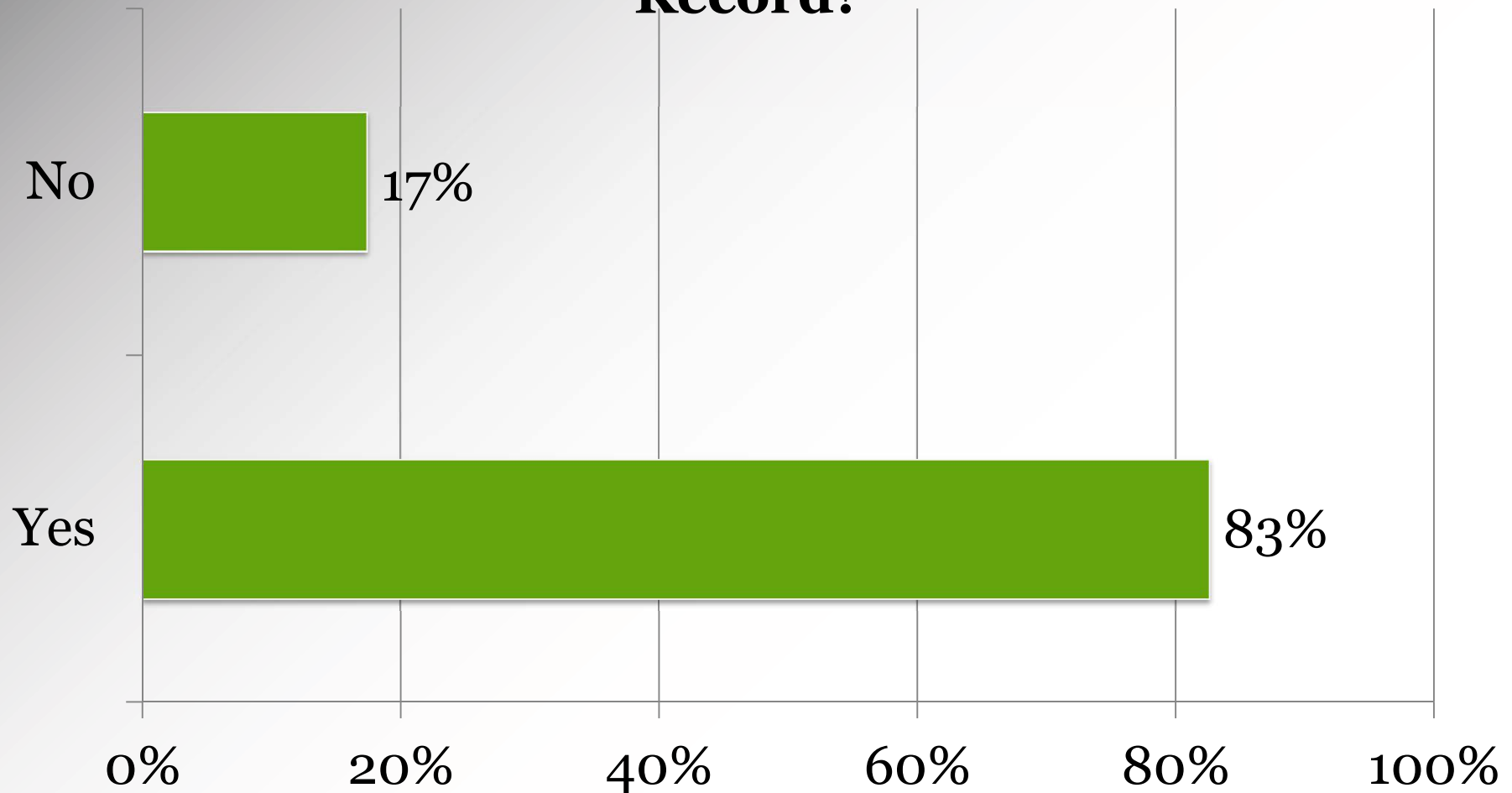

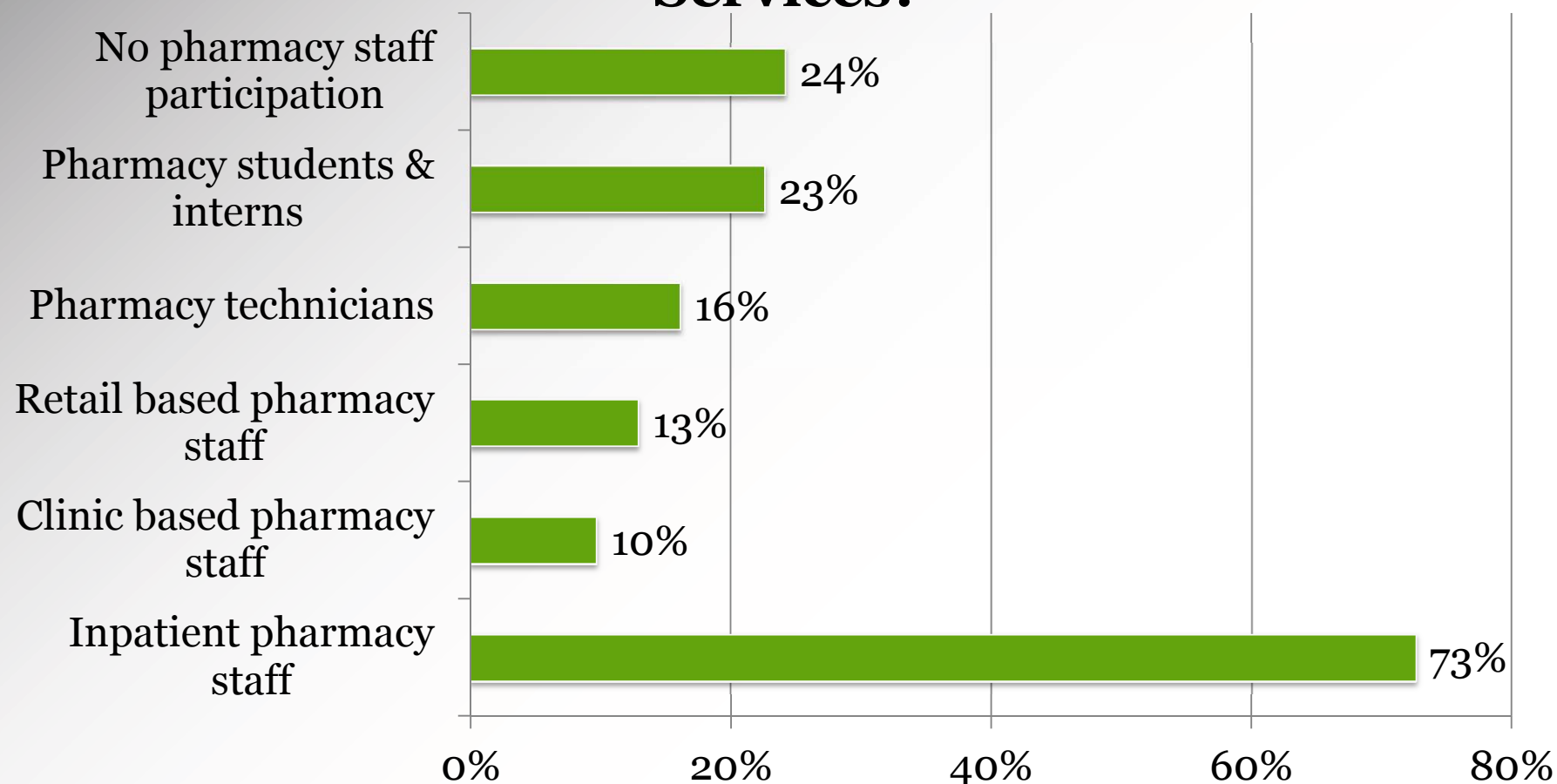
Is Discharge Medication Reconciliation or Education Documented in the Medical Record?

What Members of the Pharmacy Department Currently Participate in Transitional Care Discharge Medication Services?

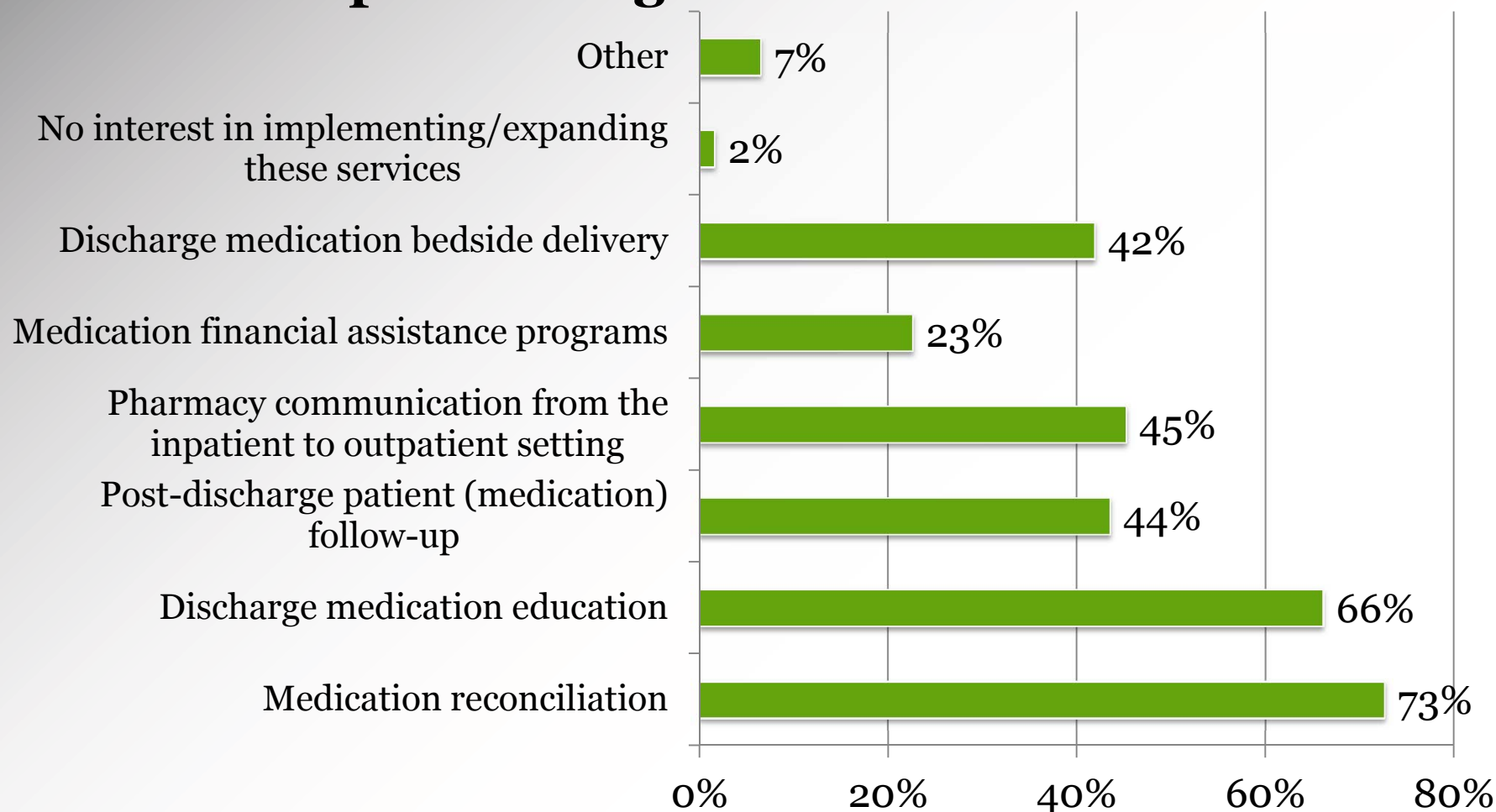

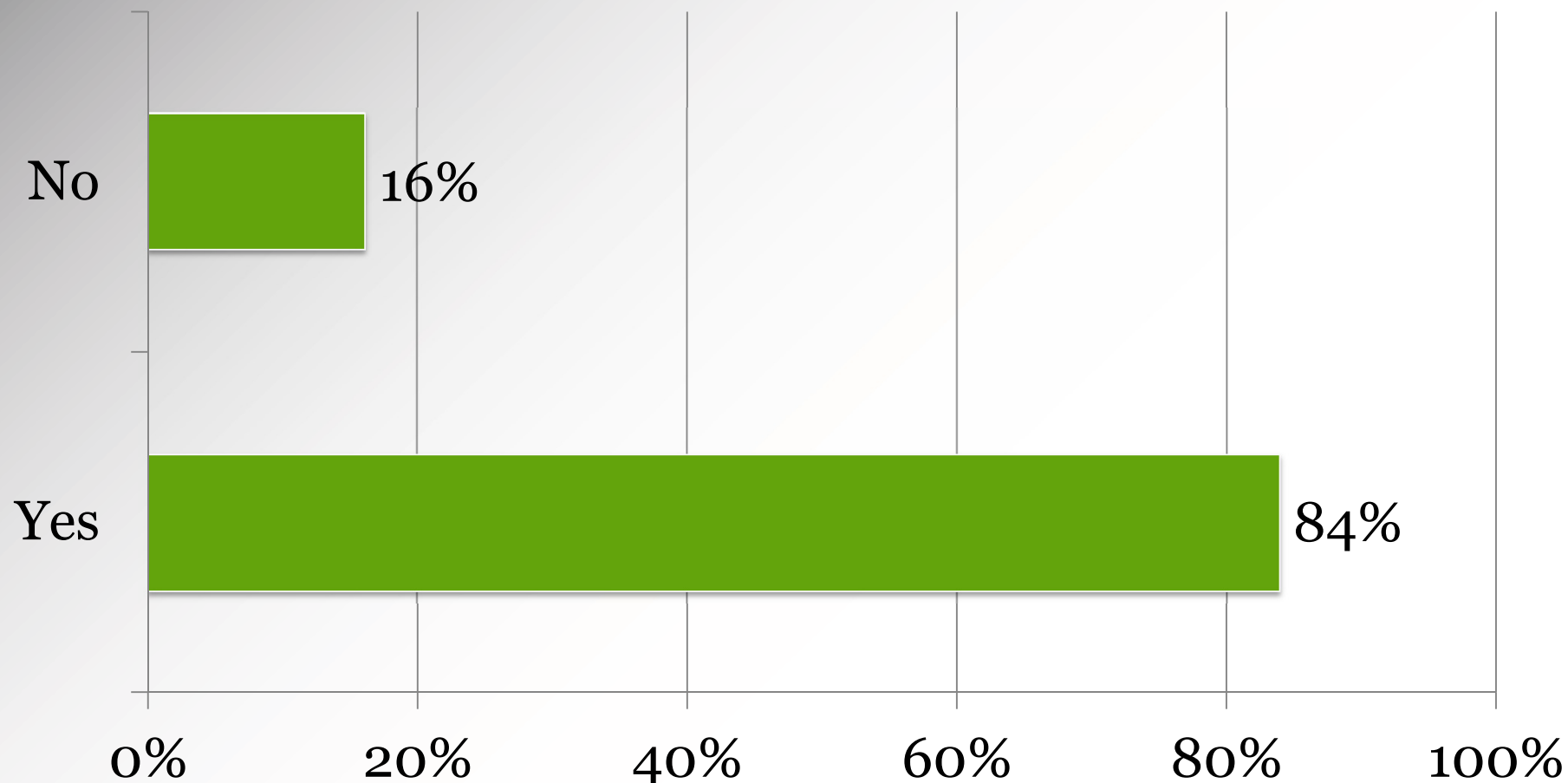

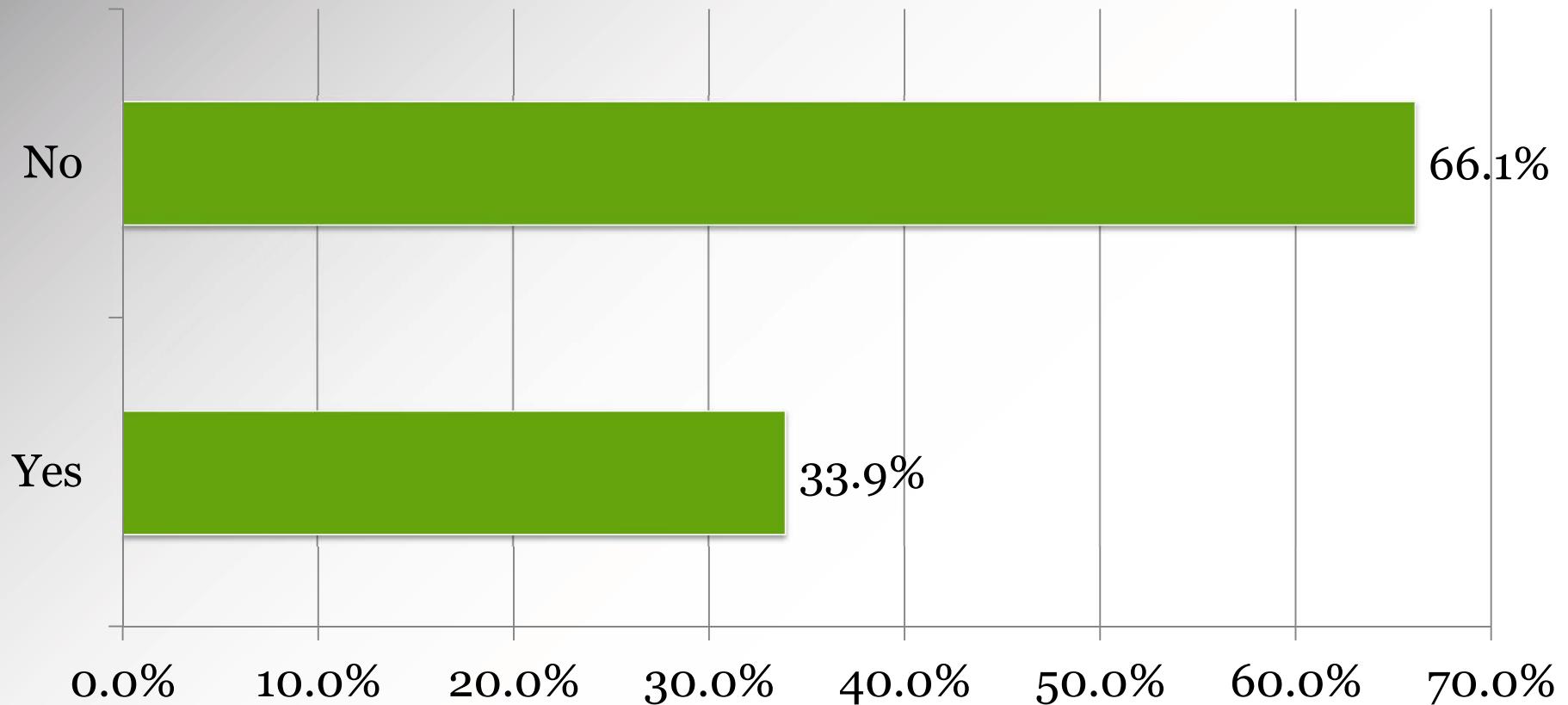
Are Pharmacists Able to Access Electronic Medical Records for Patients in Your Health System Across Care Settings?

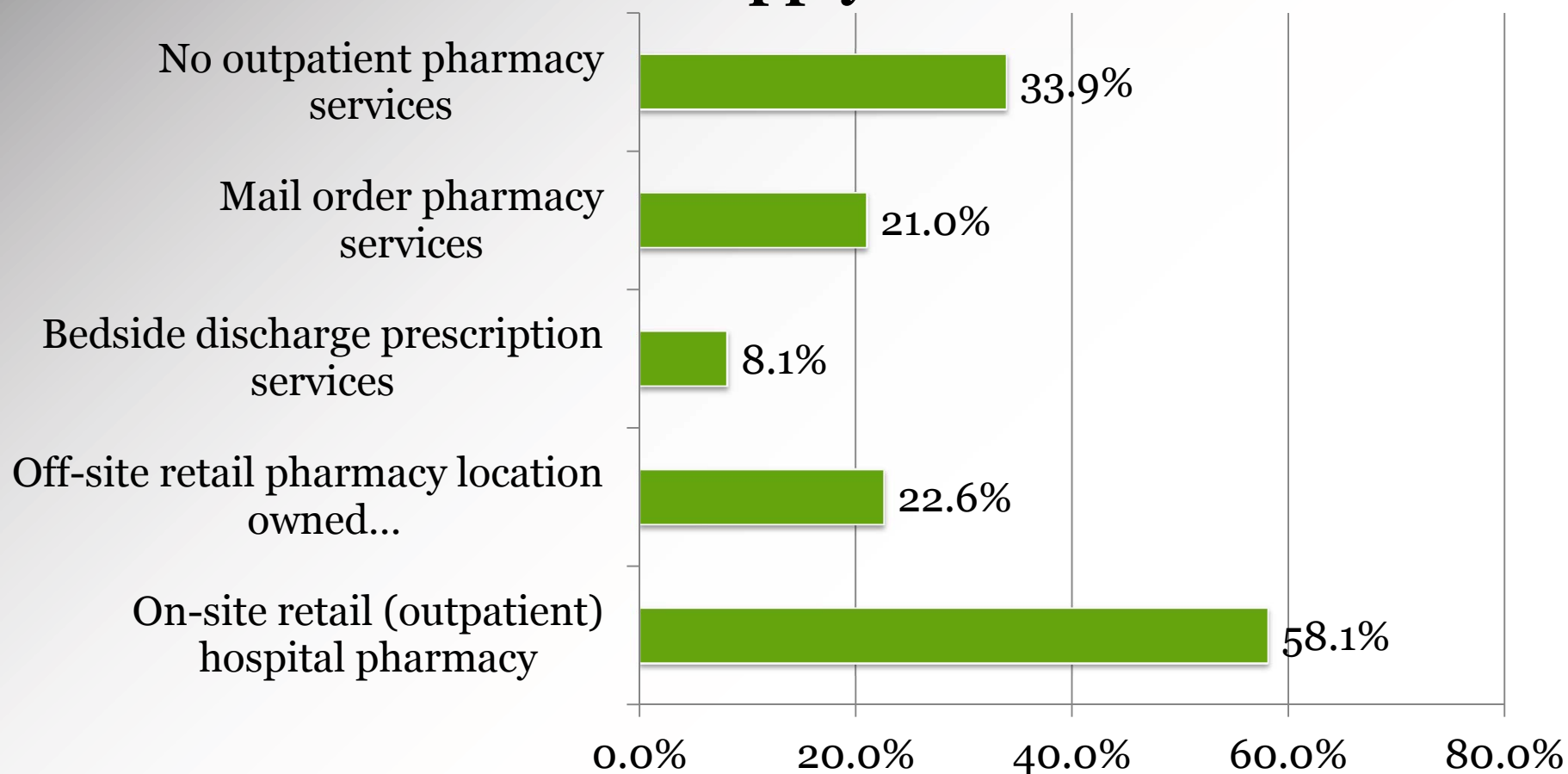
Do inpatient and outpatient pharmacists communicate regarding the transition of a patient from the inpatient to ambulatory setting and vice versa at your organization?

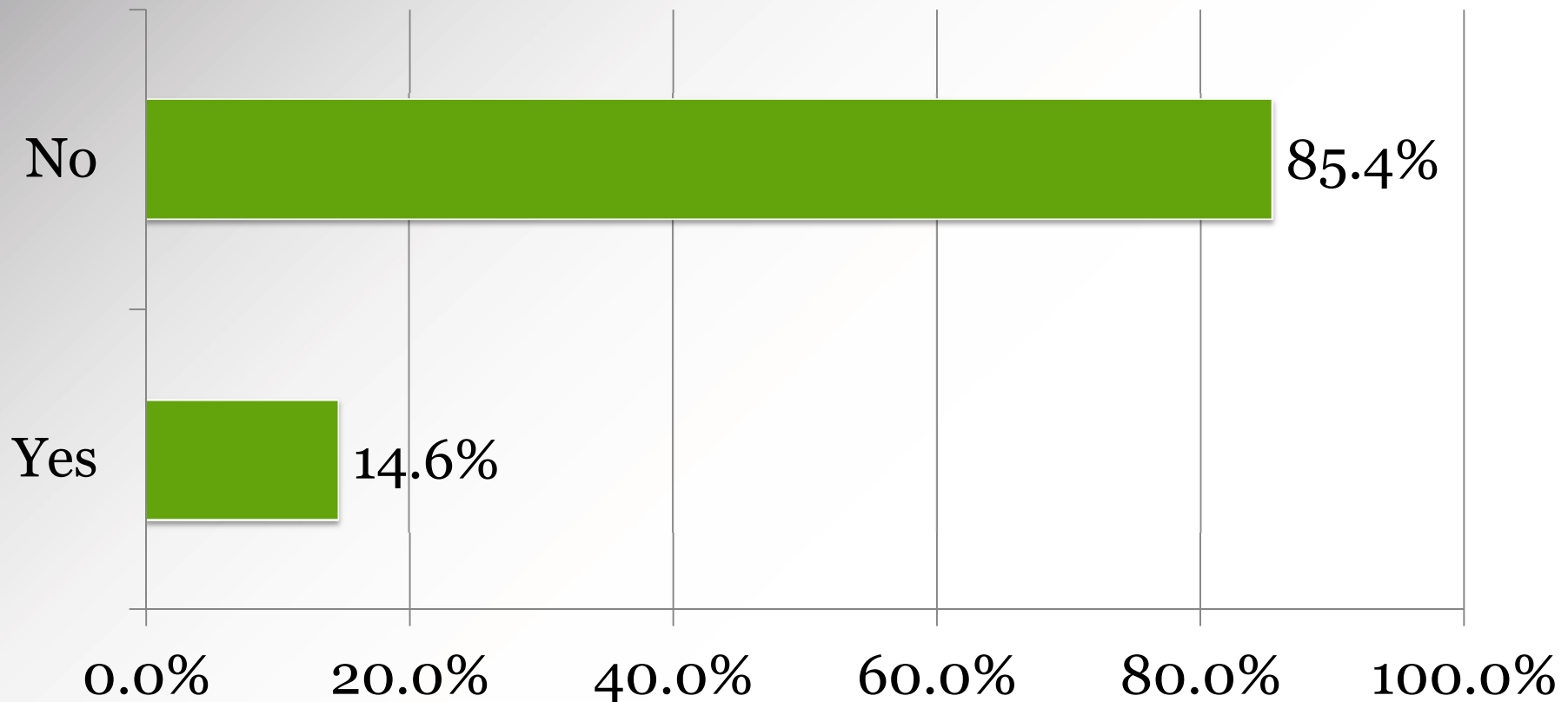

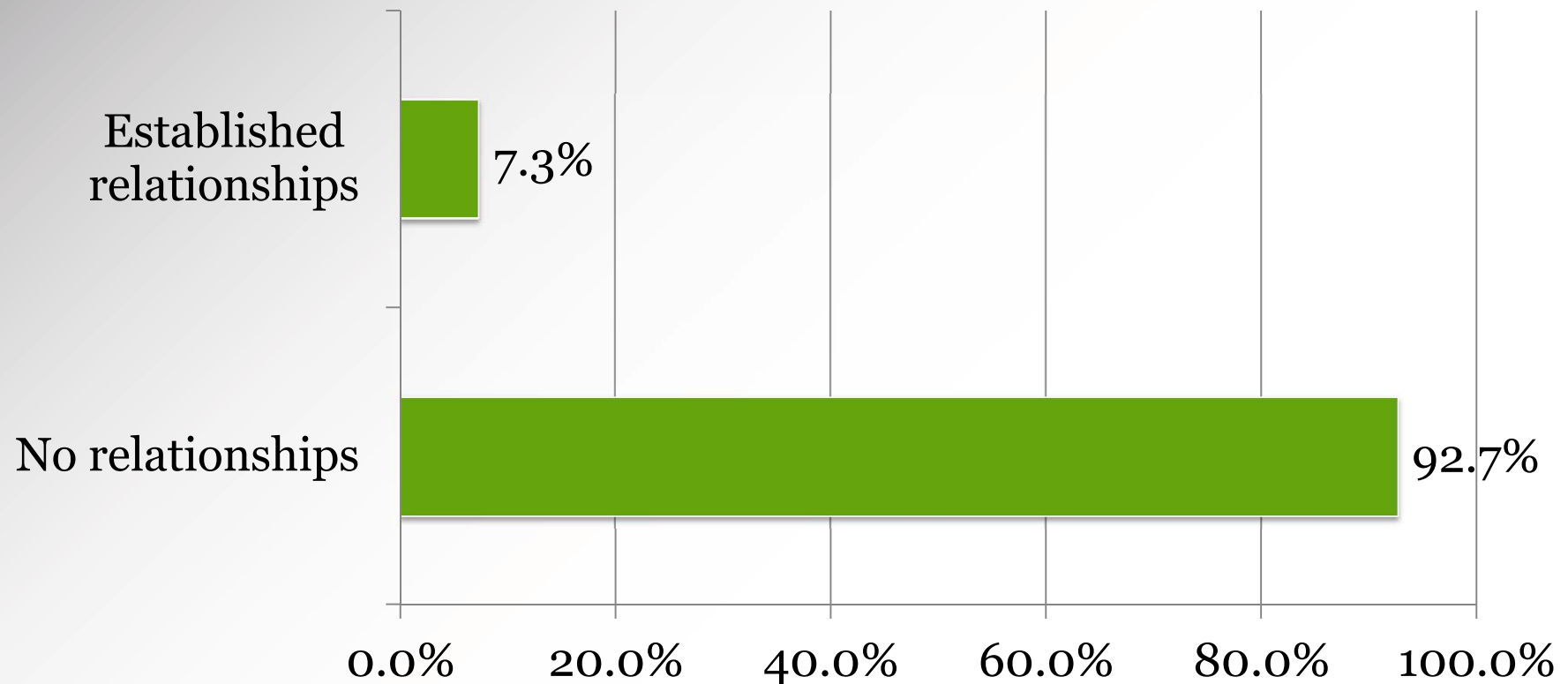

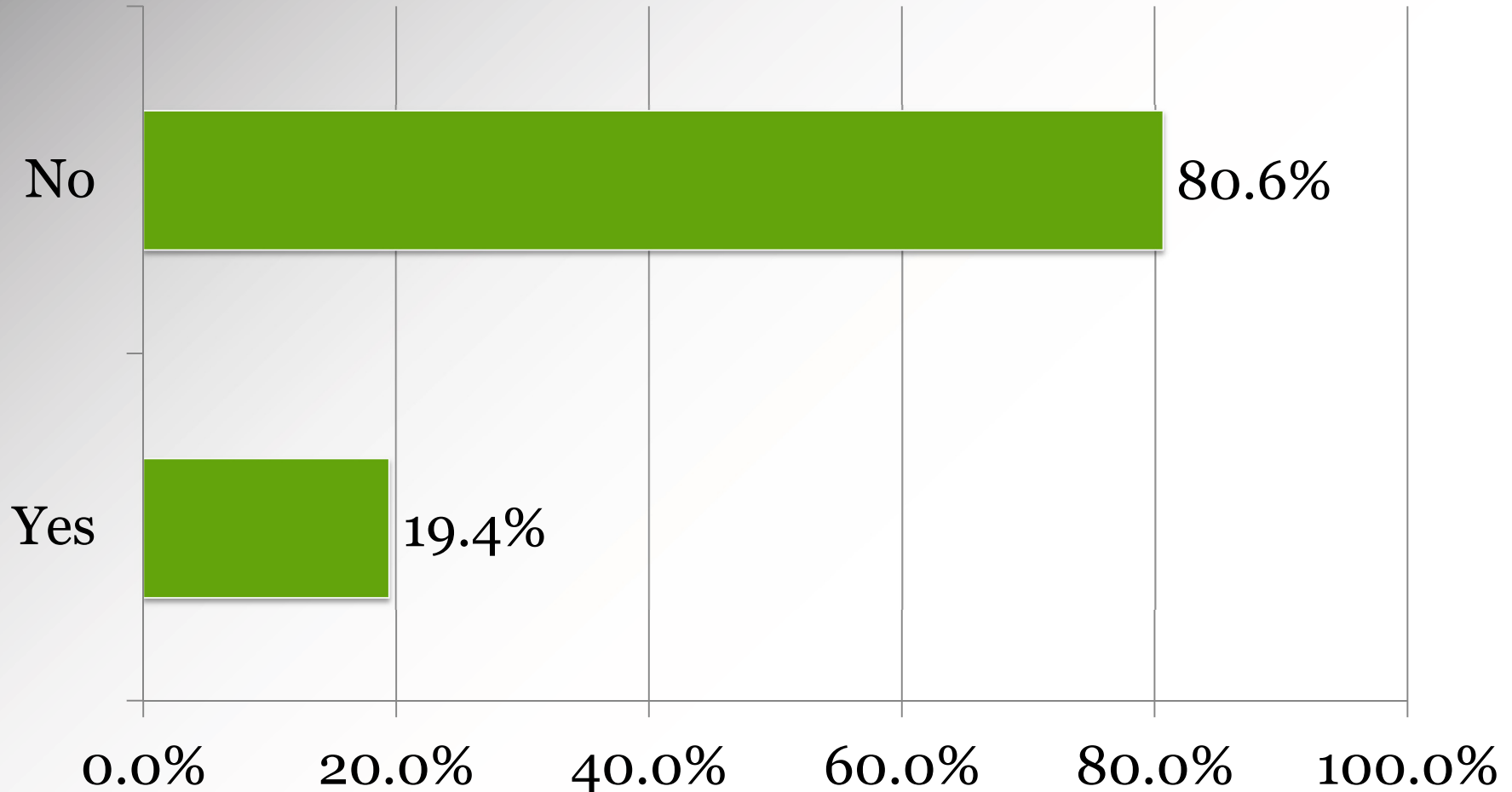

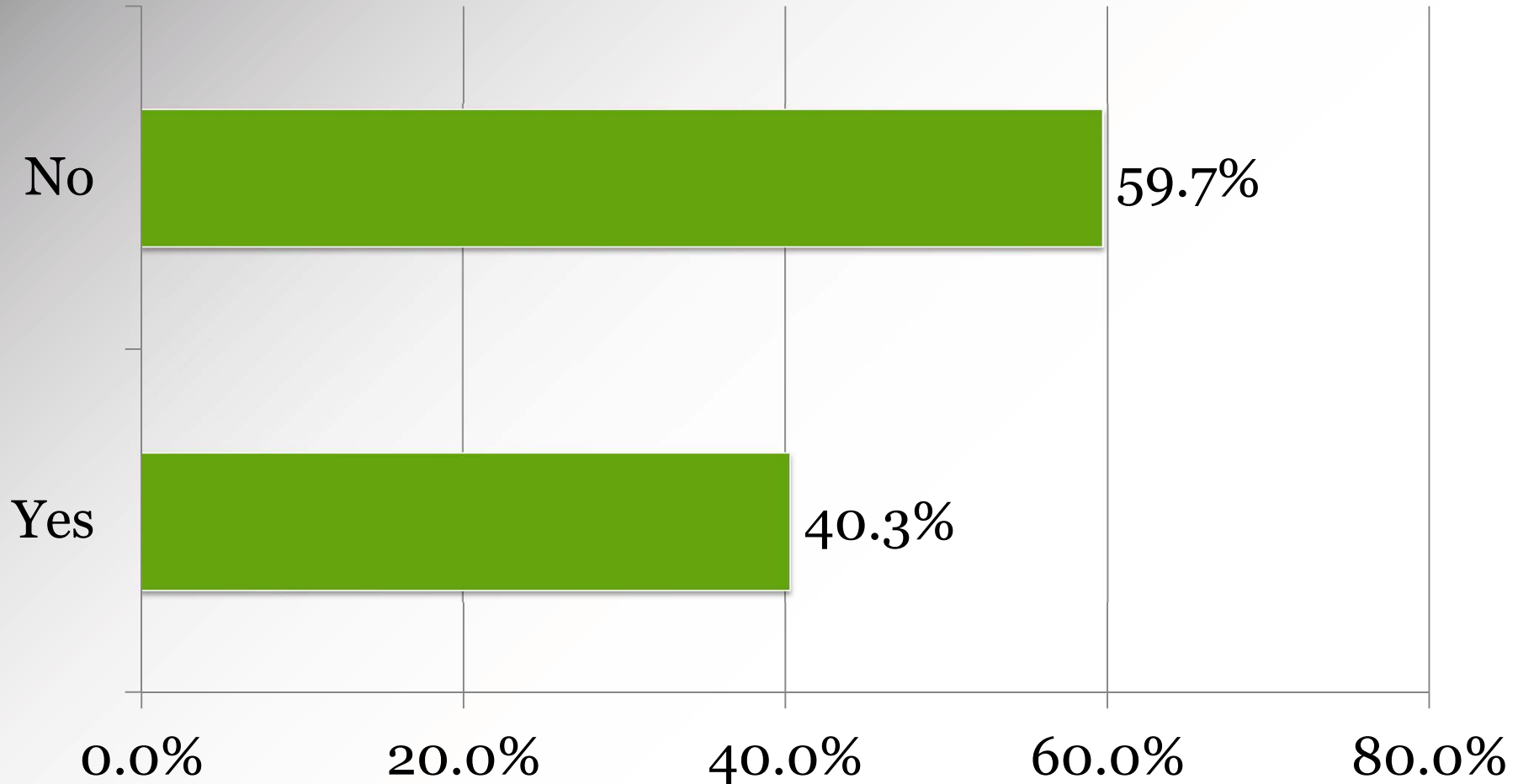
Does your hospital/health-system currently have a pharmacy led medication patient assistance program?

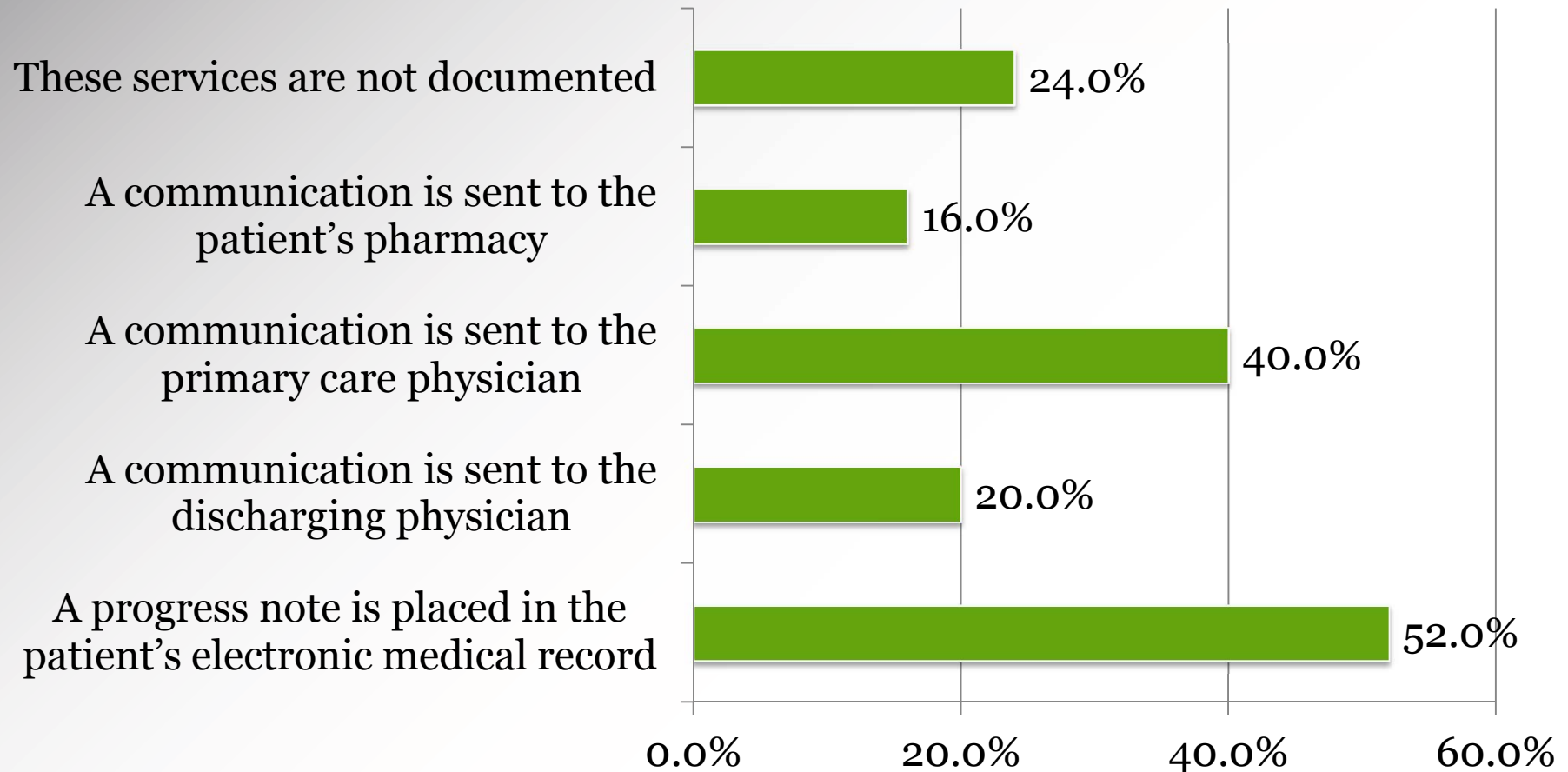
Does your hospital/health-system currently have post-discharge medication follow up services?

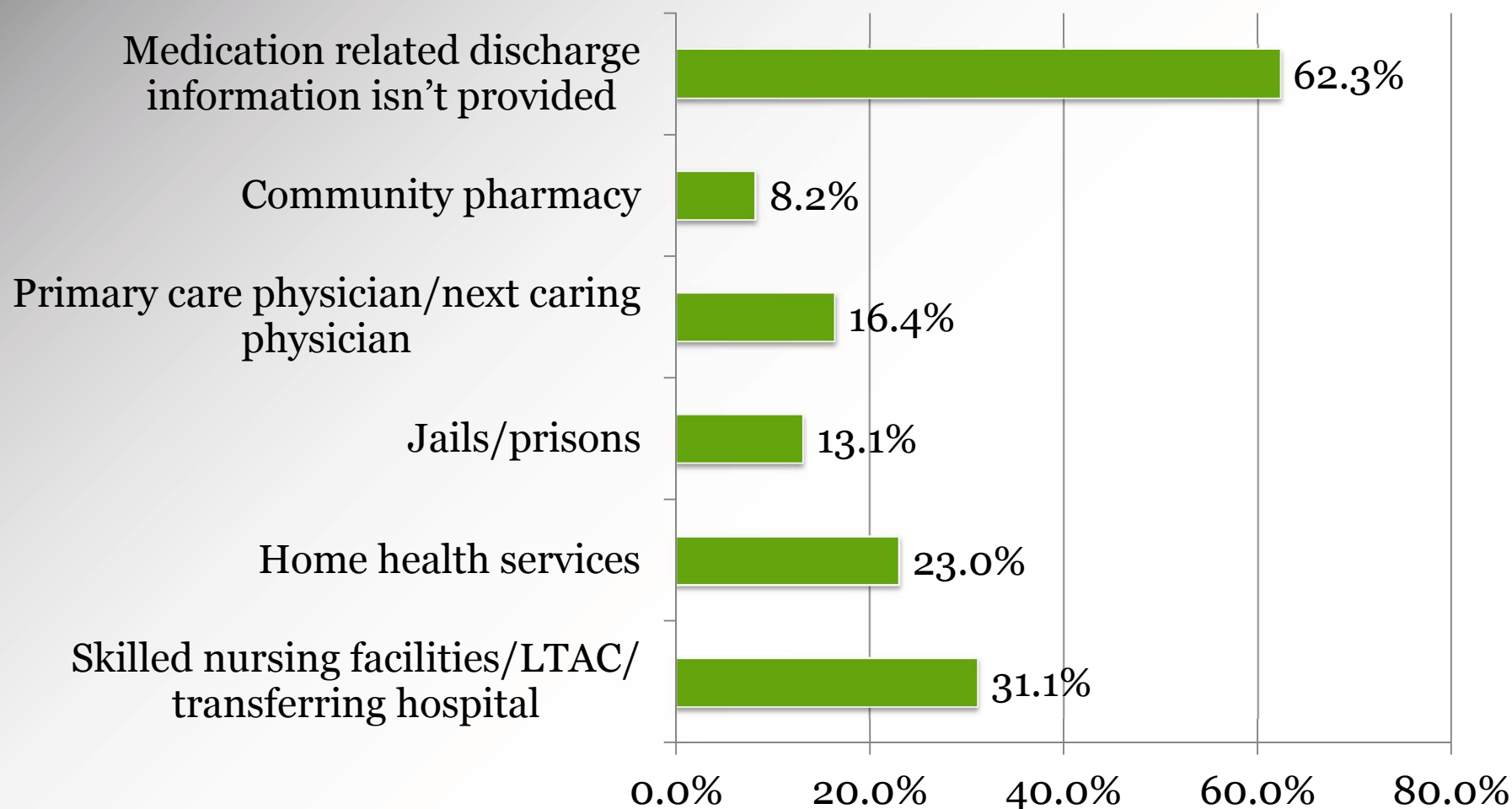

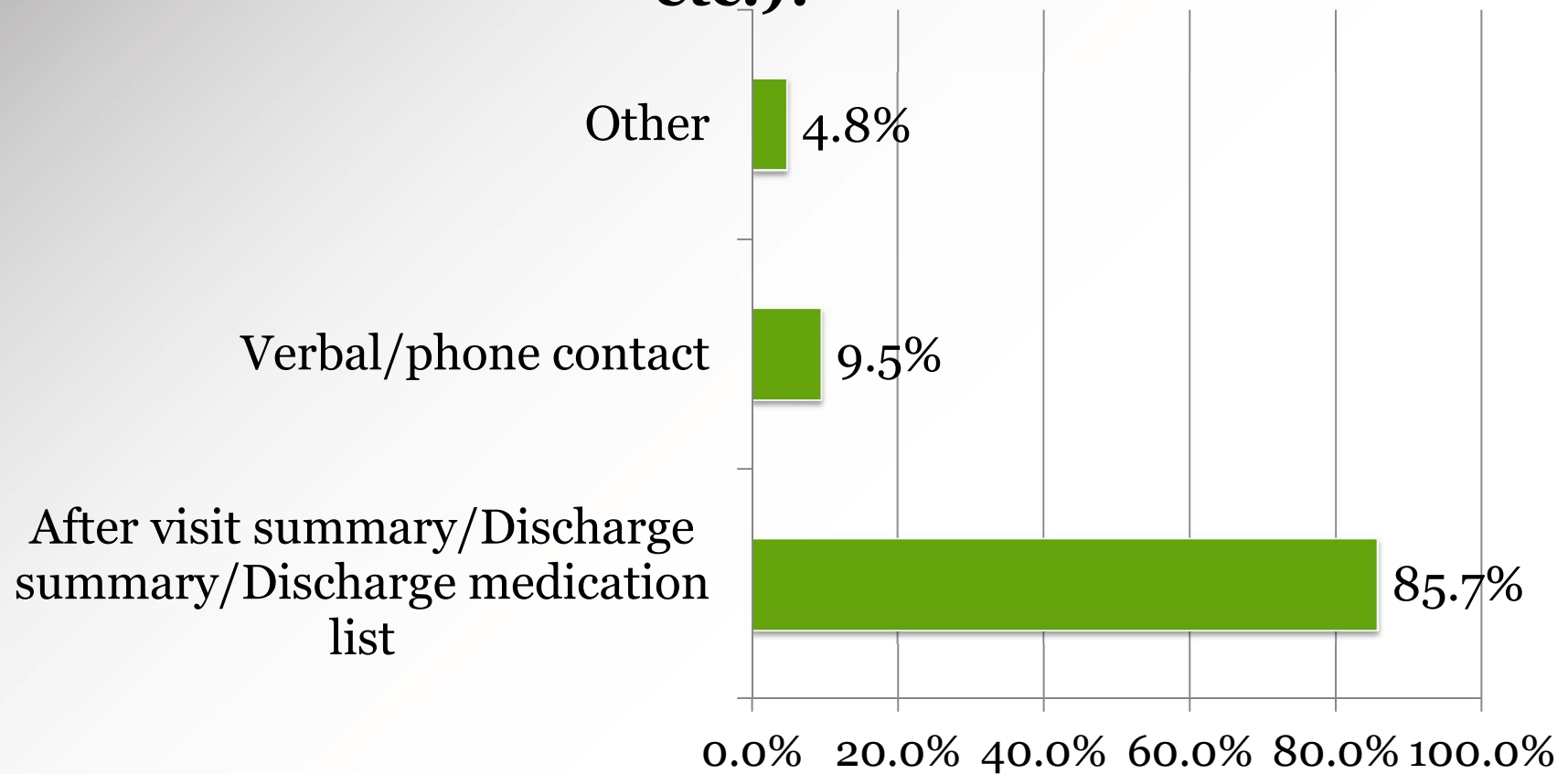

How does pharmacy communicate medication related discharge information to the patient's next health care provider (SNF, Primary Care Physician, Pharmacy, etc.)?

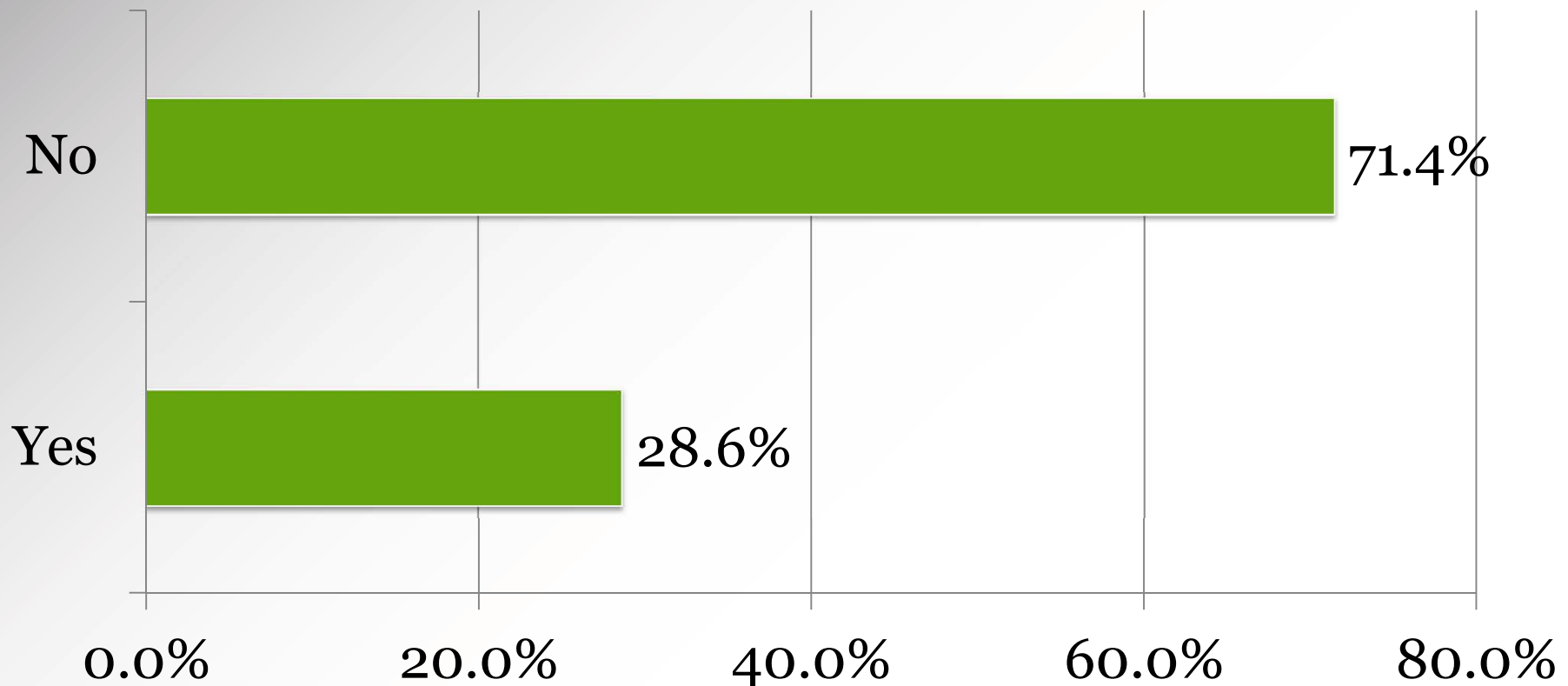

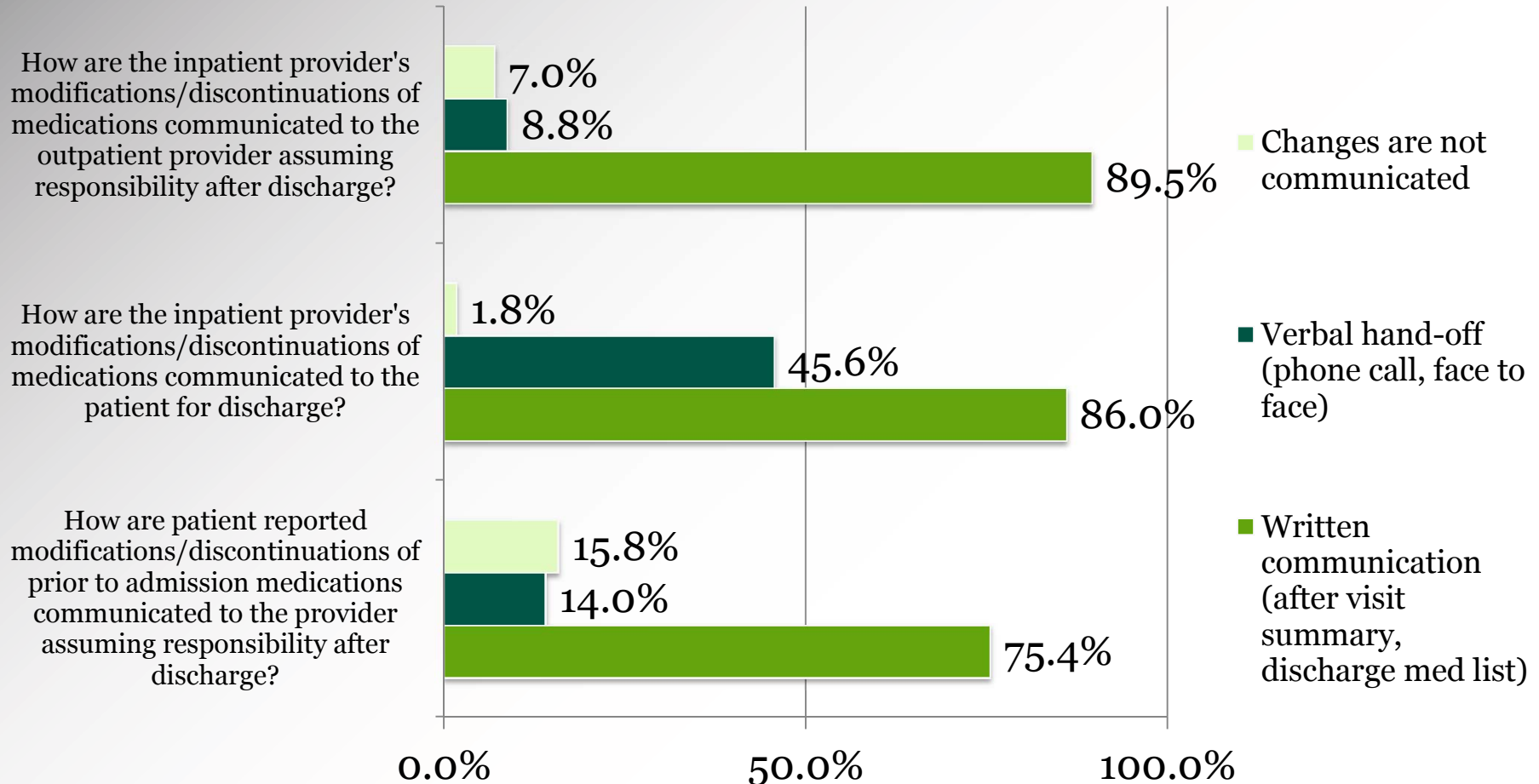
Does pharmacy communicate pertinent labs to subsequent providers assuming responsibility of care (skilled nursing facilities, home health agencies, community pharmacies)?

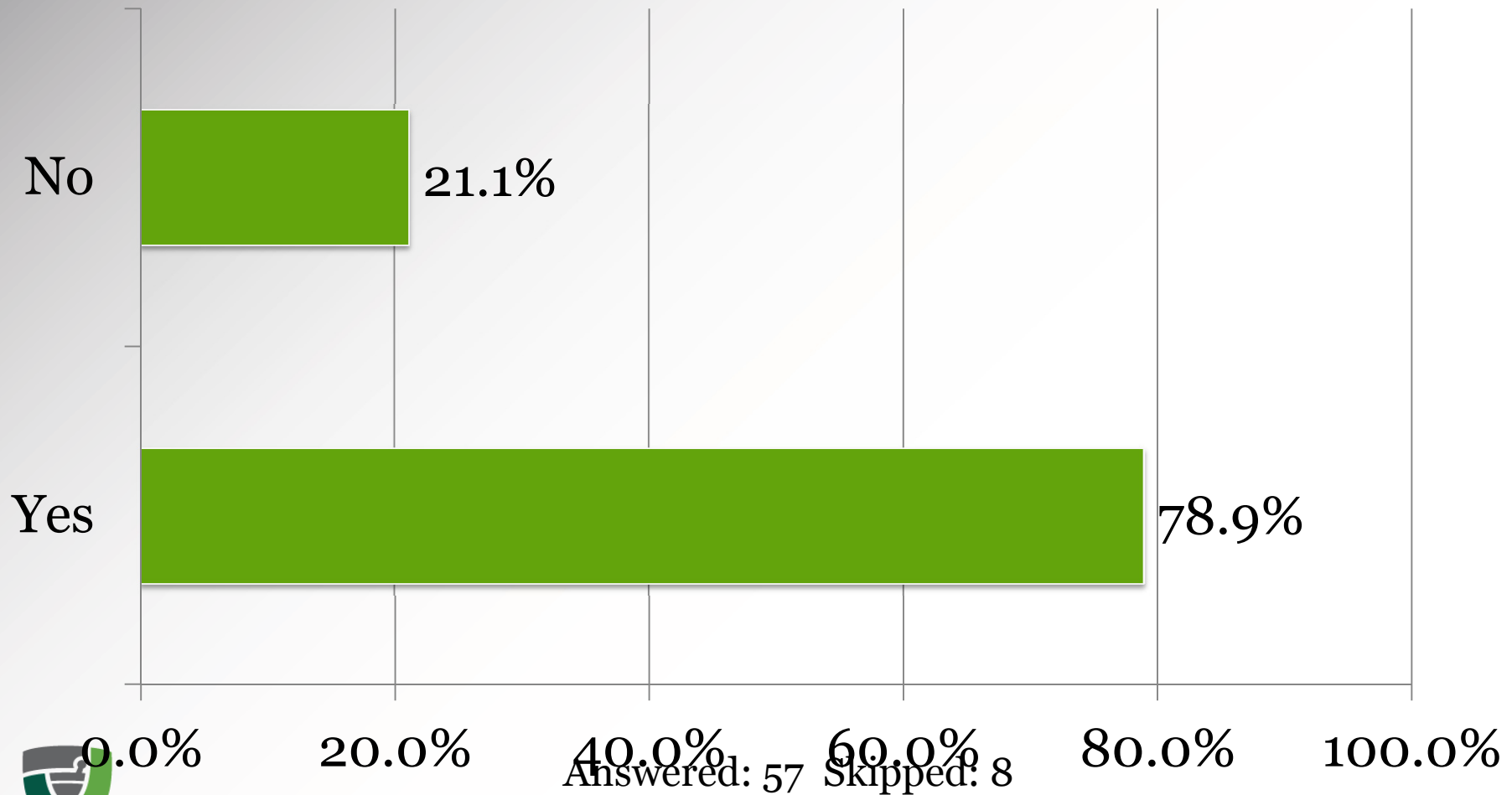

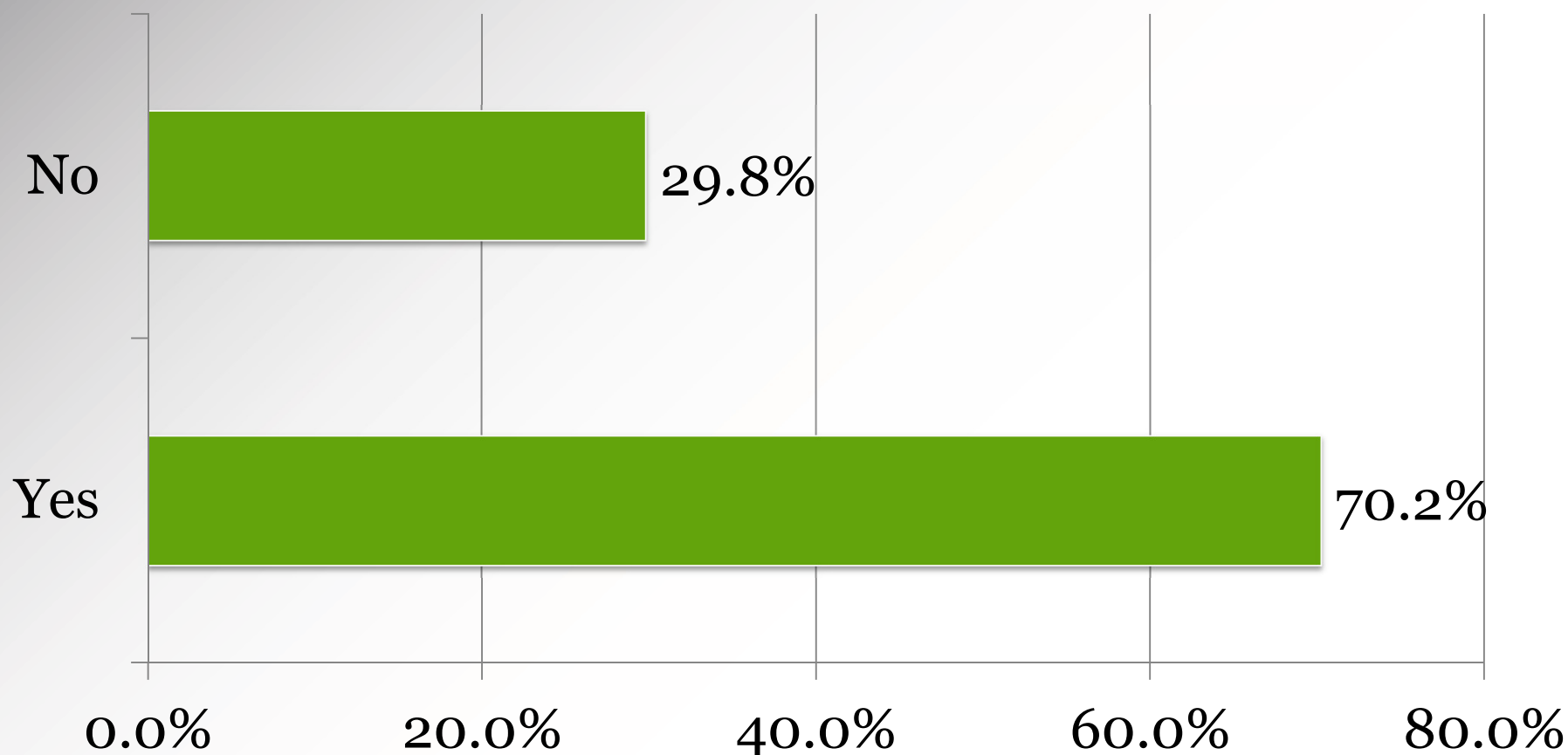
